**How to get to
Coleraine High School**

To reach the school coming from Belfast or the ring road direction, follow the "Town Centre" signs from the Lodge Road roundabout on the outskirts of Coleraine. Follow the one way system down Nursery Avenue and turn first right into Adelaide Avenue. Turn right, back onto the Lodge Road. The entrance is on the left, just past two large houses.

Those driving through Coleraine from Castlerock, Portrush, Portstewart direction enter by the main school entrance, which is on your left.
